A mammogram is an x-ray picture of the breast. Screening mammograms are used to check for breast cancer in women who have signs or symptoms of the disease.

Diagnostic mammograms are used to check for breast cancer after a lump or other sign or symptom of the disease has been found.

Screening mammography can help reduce the number of deaths from breast cancer among women ages 40 to 70.

CT Scanner Toshiba 64 CT Machine

- Offers incredible speed and coverage, 64 slice CT scans allow a diagnosis at earlier stages and without invasive or surgical procedures previously required to make a diagnosis. That means earlier treatment for potentially better outcomes.
- CT scans create incredibly detailed cross-sectional images by rotating around the body inside the gantry, which is the machine's large doughnut-shaped opening.
- A CT scanner is also unique because it can display a combination of soft tissue, bones and blood vessels in a single image.
- CT scans diagnose everything from cysts and tumors to blood diseases, blood clots,

Cardiac Screening (cash test only)

Coronary CT screens for coronary diseases in one painless rapid exam. Results are communicated directly to you. If needed, a recommendation will be made for further physician follow-up. Your scans are read and interpreted by both a board-certified cardiologist and a radiologist.

Calcium Scoring (cash test only)

The calcium score is a strong predictor of likelihood of a future heart attack. The CT scanner can be used to analyze coronary arteries and give you an accurate score.

Bone Density

A bone density test determines if you have osteoporosis, a disease that causes bones to become more fragile and more likely to break.

In the past, osteoporosis could be detected only after a bone was broken. By that time, however, bones can be quite weak. A bone density test makes it possible to know your destiny test makes it
